The French Norm (NF) is based on the same strict testing criteria as EN but the required results are even more demanding ensuring the highest standards in quality have been achieved.

Cupa H3 is available in a range of smaller sizes, the most popular being 50x25cm. As the authorised Cupa distributor for Ireland, Capco Roofing carries extensive

stocks of this size in their roofing centres.

Guarantee

Cupa H3 slate is certified as A1, S1, T1 and conforms to EN 12326-1:2004 – Slate and Stone products for discontinuous roofing.

Cupa H3 slate is expected to exceed the life of the building and a formal manufacturer backed guarantee of 100 years is available when the slate is fitted in accordance with ICP2:2002 and BS5534:2003.
